



- ✓ 9" x 12" (23 cm x 30.5 cm) construction paper
- ✓ scissors
- ✓ glue
- ✓ art supplies (e.g., crayons, markers, paint/paintbrush, glitter, ribbon)
- ✓ stapler
- ✓ paper

Paper Doll Books

Show children how to fold a piece of construction paper into eight equal sections. Have children place their paper in a landscape position and cut out the bottom left and bottom right sections for later use. Show them how to fold the top right and top left sections inward to make a "jacket."

Tell children to glue one of the section cutouts behind each side of the jacket to make arms. Ask children to trace a circle on construction paper, cut it out, and glue it to the top to make a head. Encourage them to add paper hands and feet. Invite children to use art supplies to add facial features and details to the clothing.

Have them open the jacket and staple paper behind it to make a book. Tell children to write a title and their name on the front of the jacket.
