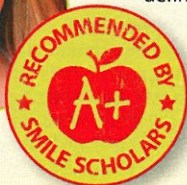

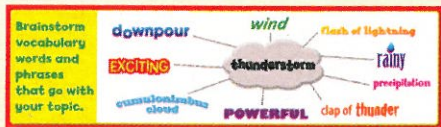
## Help Students add spice to their writing!
