



Concentration Game

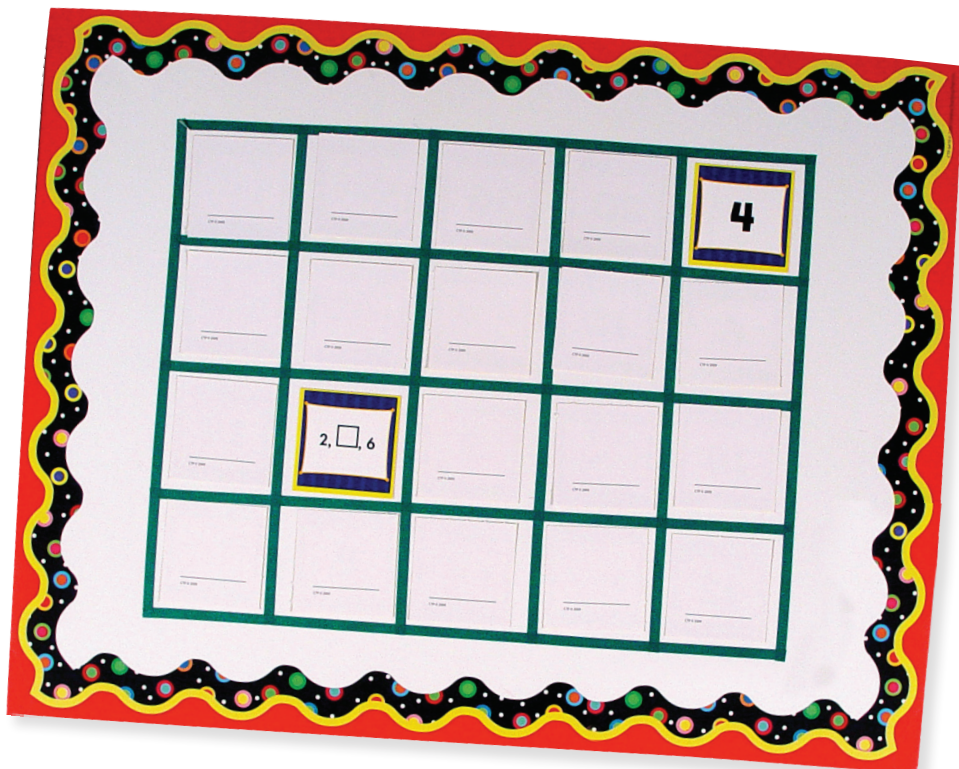
Materials:

Math Games Galore: Number Sense and Place Value book, Gr. 1 (CTP 6356)

Dots on a Wave Blank Chart (CTP 6419)

colored masking tape

ruler



Directions:

1. Select a game from the book, and separate the game cards along the perforated lines.
2. Make a grid using a ruler and colored masking tape to measure $2\frac{1}{2}$ inch squares on a Dots on a Wave Blank Chart.
3. Place the cards facedown in 4 rows of 5 cards. The grid will help students organize the cards in lines, which will help them remember the placement of the cards.
4. Encourage students to take turns turning over pairs of cards and trying to find a match, just like in traditional memory or concentration games. If there is a question about a match, students refer to the answer key.

Tip:

Laminate the answer key cards and the game cards for durability. Attach the answer key to the inside of a resealable plastic bag and place the game cards inside. Use the bag to store the game.
