



Five Little Pumpkins Poem

Materials:

- Pumpkin Calendar Cut-Outs (CTP 4953)
- Pumpkin Super Cut-Outs (CTP 4887)
- Black Spumoni Uppercase Letter Stickers (CTP 4634)
- Black Spumoni Lowercase Letter Stickers (CTP 4635)
- glue
- orange paper
- ribbon
- scissors
- craft sticks

Directions:

1. Print the Five Little Pumpkins poem on orange paper.

Five Little Pumpkins

Five little pumpkins sitting on a gate.
The first one said, "Oh, my it's getting late!"
The second one said, "There are witches in the air!"
The third one said, "But we don't care."
The fourth one said, "Let's run, let's run!"
The fifth one said, "Isn't Halloween fun?"

Then Woooooo went the wind
And OUT went the lights.

And five little pumpkins rolled out of sight.

2. Cut out the poem, and glue it to a Pumpkin Super Cut-Out. Make one for each student.

3. Use Black Spumoni Lowercase or Uppercase Letters Stickers to number 1–5 on five Pumpkin Calendar Cut-Outs.
4. Glue the Pumpkin Calendar Cut-Outs on craft sticks.
5. Decorate the pumpkins with ribbon.
6. Have students act out the poem using the pumpkin sticks. Choose a narrator and have other students speak the line for their corresponding pumpkin number. Have the class read along using the poem printed on the Pumpkin Super Cut-Outs.



Tip:

To create a different version of this activity, place Pumpkin Super Cut-Outs on brown paper lunch bags (instead of craft sticks) to make pumpkin puppets.
