



Anecdotal Records

Materials:

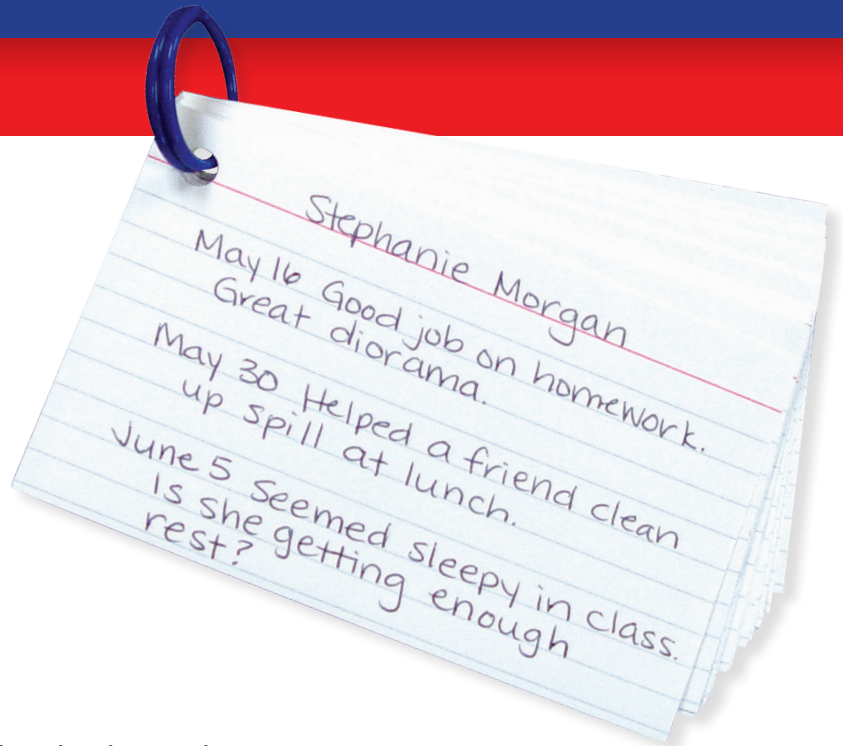
Poppin' Patterns Record Book (CTP 1277)

Blue Large 1¼" Ring-Its!® (CTP 1715)

hole punch

index cards

pens or pencils



Directions:

1. Punch a hole in the top left-hand corner of lined index cards, fasten the cards together with a Ring-Its! fastener.
2. Write a student's name at the top of each card.
3. As you observe behavior or class work of a student, note it on the child's card along with the date.
4. Periodically transfer this information to your record book (page 12 of CTP 1277), indicating in the box the date of the observation.
5. When you conference with the parents, reference your record book. For the dates that you made observations, refer to the file cards for exactly what you observed and share this information with the parents.
6. After the conference with the parents, record the meeting on the Parent Contact Checklist (page 11 of CTP 1277).

Tip:

When one note card is full, just open the Ring-Its! and simply slide another index card on the Ring-its!
