



## Scenes from a Snowy Day

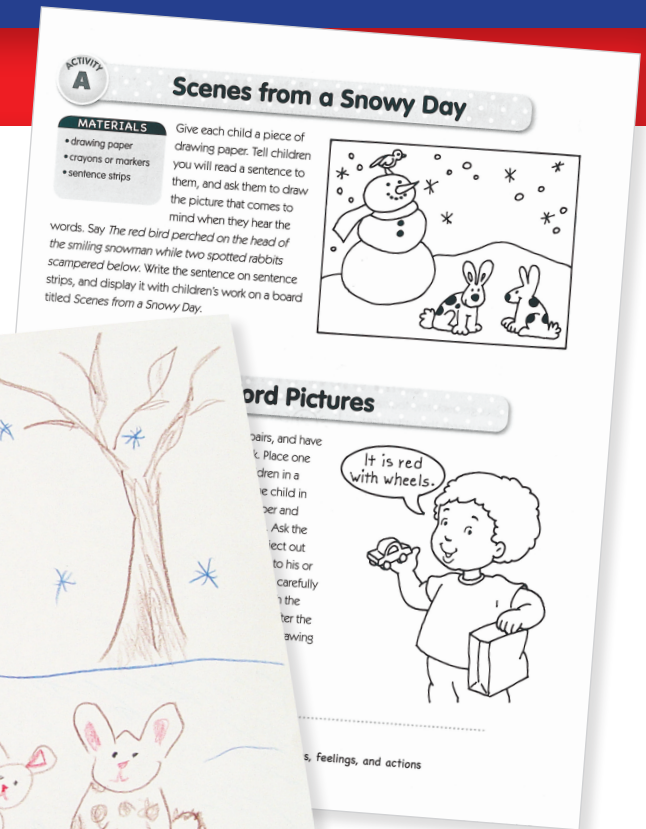
### Materials:

*Building a Community of Writers* resource book (CTP 2212)

crayons or markers

drawing paper

sentence strips



### Directions:

1. Following the directions from the *Building a Community of Writers* resource book, give each child a piece of drawing paper.
2. Tell children you will read a sentence to them, and ask them to draw the picture that comes to mind when they hear the words. Say, *The red bird was perched on the head of the smiling snowman while two spotted rabbits scampered below.*
3. Write the sentence on sentence strips, and display it with children's work on a bulletin board display titled *Scenes from a Snowy Day*.

### Tip:

Praise anything children write or draw. Do not force children to read or write, but encourage them.
