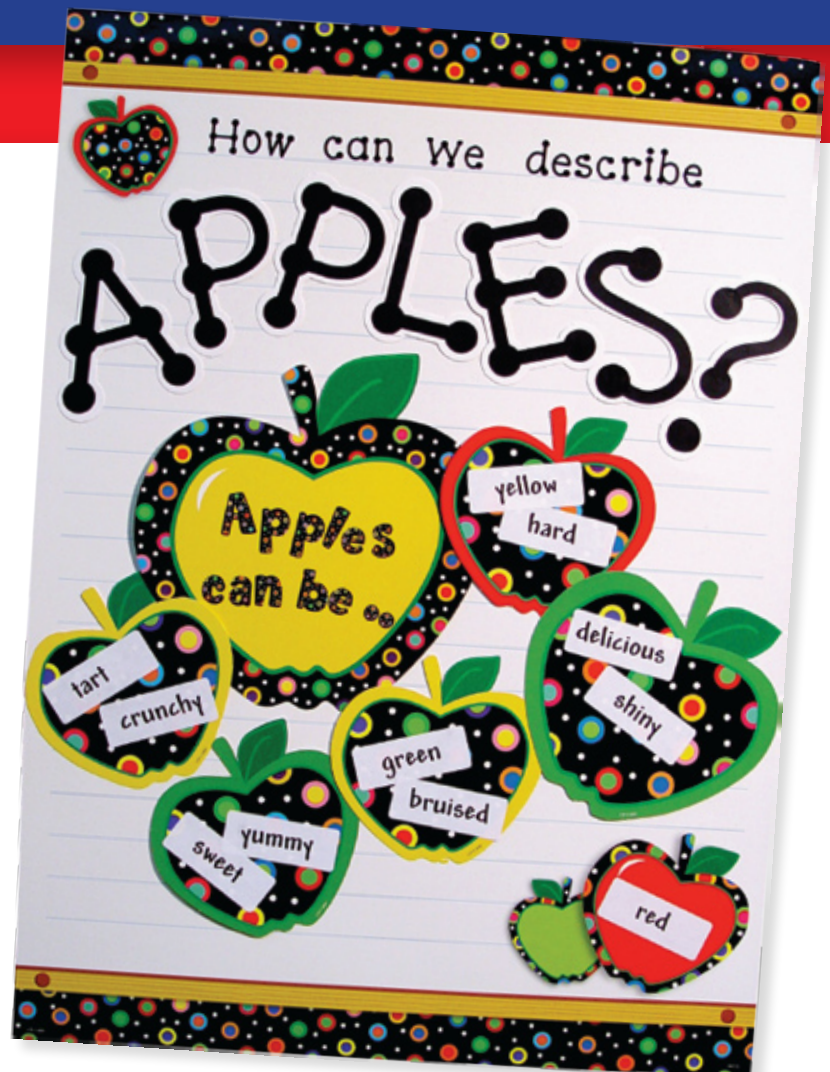
1" Poppin' Patterns Dots on Black

Directions:

1. Using the Black Dot-to-Dot Designer Letters and letter stickers; write out *How can we describe APPLES?* on the chart provided with the bulletin board set.
2. Next, write out *Apples can be..* on an accent apple using the Dots on Black Letter Stickers. Affix apple to chart.
3. Invite each student to bring an apple to class.
4. Ask students to examine their apples and share their observations. Record the adjectives the students use on the student apples. Affix apples to chart.
5. Ask students to sample their apples and describe the taste. Add the taste adjectives to the student apples.

Tip:

Invite students to write apple recipes. Display students work around the bulletin board.
