

Title I, Part C—Education of Migratory Children

Goal: To support high-quality and comprehensive educational programs for migrant children to help reduce the educational disruptions and other problems that result from repeated moves.

What/Who For: To provide migratory children with appropriate programs/resources that can travel with them as they move, so as to not disrupt the child's education.

Use of Funds

Provide resources that are mobile so that students can take with them as they migrate to different locations and still stay within a certain curriculum.
